AM KIDS CLUB FOR GRADES K-6

Start the school day with quiet games, lively conversation, or simple arts and crafts! Our instructor keeps the mornings interesting with stories, artifacts, and activities at Watts Ice Center. Participants from West School must register for shuttle bus service from the Park District; South School students will be walked to school.

PM KIDS CLUB FOR GRADES K-6

After a busy day at school, it's great to snack and chat with friends, finish homework, and stretch muscles in the gym or on the playground. After-Schoolers cook healthy snacks, play organized games, and embark on learning adventures at Watts Ice Center. Participants from West School must register for shuttle bus service to the Park District; South School students will be walked to Watts.

NEW! KIDS CLUB BUS

The Park District is now offering a registered morning and afternoon bus service from West School to Kids Club. Parents no longer need to register for bus services through District 35 for Kids Club. Kids Club teachers will escort students by foot between Kids Club and South School, so students in grades K-2 do not need to register for the Kids Club Bus. Limited bus spaces are available. Fee includes bus service five days per week for the 2017-18 school year. Prorating and refunds are not available. Spots in this program cannot be held for those who wish to not use Kid's Club for a month. Those participants must dis-enroll and re-enroll as space permits. The \$125 registration fee will only be charged once per school year.

REGISTRATION

To reserve a place for the 2017-18 school year, there is a \$125 non-refundable, non-transferable registration fee per child. Tuition will be assessed monthly beginning September 1, 2017; you can sign up for a monthly auto-charge. Online registration is unavailable; to register, please fill out a Kids Club registration form (available at the Takiff Center or download the form online). You must register by fax or in person at least 5 business days prior to upcoming the month.

NEW! LAST MINUTE CARE

With Last Minute Care, we got you covered! One day shuttle bus service, as well as morning/afternoon Kids Club is now here. You will need to notify the Park District and School District 35 one business day before attending. Limit ten uses per school year. Must register in person; subject to classroom availability.



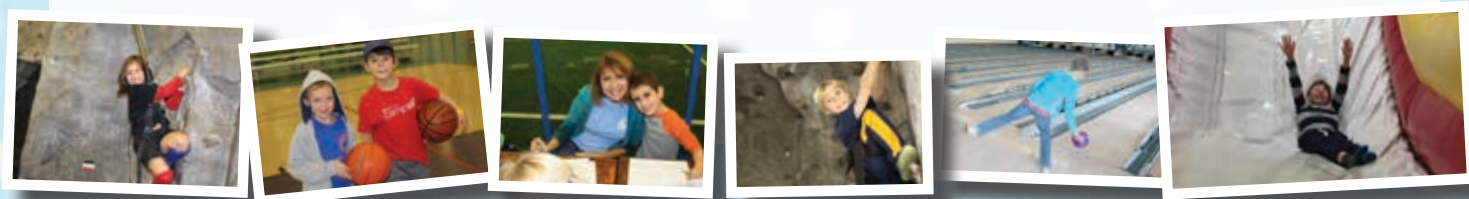
BAKE & DECORATE (1/2): Join us at the Takiff Center for a baking party! We will bake cookies and create cooking-themed crafts.
