Dear Teddies Families:

We are happy to have your child with us this summer in Teddy Bears Camp. The Teddy Bear counselors will be Morgan Henry & Layne Dubose. Teddy Bears meet from 9:15 to 11:15 a.m. on Monday, Wednesday and Fridays or Tuesdays and Thursdays, from June 19th through August 11th, in Room 212.

Orientation: For Parents and Child

Monday, June 19, will be a short orientation for children and parents together. This is for MWF children and their parents.

Tuesday, June 20 will be the orientation for Tu/Th children and their parents.

The orientation will be from 9:15 to 10:15a.m. in Room 212. In order for your child to meet his/her camp directors and adjust to the classroom, we request that siblings do not attend.

Children will stay the entire time the second day of camp, June 21 for MWF campers and June 22 for Tu/Th campers. **If you have concerns about your child's separation, please let your child's camp directors know.**

Things to Bring to Orientation: (PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING)

- Change of clothes, labeled with your child's name: shoes, socks, pants, shirt and diapers/underwear in a plastic bag
- Photograph of your family with names on the back
- Extra wipes and diapers if your child is not potty trained

Birthday/Treats:

If your child has a birthday during camp and you would like to send a treat that day, please contact your child's teachers. Please avoid foods containing nuts and nut products.

Transportation/Parking:

Please park your car and accompany your child into the classroom. At drop-off and pick-up times, park your car in a designated parking space. **Parking is not permitted along the front curb.** Please pick up your child promptly at 11:15am in the classroom.

If someone other than you or the individuals listed on the Camper Information Form will be picking up your child, please send a written note with instructions. Please remind your alternate pick-up person to bring photo identification.
