GJK camp is eight weeks and runs from June 11-August 3. Tuition payment for GJK camps is due by April 2, 2012. GJK camps are not available for online registration.

GJK's Junior Counselor program is designed to introduce young people entering 7th, 8th and 9th grades to the work environment. We understand that for most kids, this is their first job, and our goal is to make this experience a positive one. Our goals for the Jr. Counselor program are to:

1. Provide young counselors an opportunity to learn about the work environment.
2. Create specific responsibilities for each Jr. Counselor, which helps him or her to learn time management, organization, and follow through.
3. Have each Jr. Counselor work closely with a group of children to form attachments with the children.

2. We will foster responsibility and a sense of commitment with your child.

Counselors are asked to be responsible, reliable, and professional, and should have a desire to work with young children.
