With access to softball, soccer, indoor gym games, ceramics and art studios, a stage, enrichment rooms, and much more, the Takiff Center provides an opportunity for lots of active play!

**Special Activities** Some elements that set Sun Fun apart from other camps are our unique special event and dress up days, such as Carnival Day and Color Wars. This year, these events are kicked up a notch with new activities and entertainers. We are also welcoming specialty staff to help the campers with cooking, ceramics, and sports. The fun doesn't stop there! Campers enjoy "Camper's Choice," a portion of the day in which they can participate in an activity of their choosing, such as games, photography or basketball.

**Field Trips/Overnight** Sun Fun ventures out on weekly field trips to exciting places such as the Wheeling Aquatic Center, Pump it Up, eSkape, and many more. Our annual Camp Overnight will be extra fun this year with the addition of an evening field trip! On that day, campers now have the opportunity to stay at the Takiff Center after the regular camp day to transition directly into the sleepover activities. Dinner and breakfast are included with the overnight.

**Glencoe Beach/Swim Lessons** Once a week, Sun Fun campers walk to Glencoe Beach for swimming, sand castle contests, and other games. They also enjoy indoor swim lessons, held once a week at the Park District of Highland Park Recreation Center. Lessons are divided by grade level and **included in your camp fee**. Campers receive a half-hour free swim and a half-hour lesson.

Camp fee includes three T-shirts, a camp picture, the Camp Overnight, several cookouts, special events, and weekly field trips. We provide refrigeration for lunches when on site, and are now offering a lunch service through Kiddos Catering, Inc. Lunch service will not be available for some field trips.
