Children's Circle Belugas: Before and After Kindergarten

Paint like Seurat, design a solar system, build a body complete with organs - the Belugas program enriches your kindergartner's day with explorations and experiences over a wild range of topics! This wrap-around program is available from 7 a.m.- 12 p.m., and from 3:30-6:30 p.m. We provide snacks, a hot lunch and a host of activities, from yoga to gardening. We also provide full-day fun on many of the days that South School is closed, for no extra charge.

Introduction to the Arts

In this unique class, kindergartners get their first taste of famous masterpieces! Children not only learn to identify famous works of art, but also learn to explore and appreciate art through the ages. After learning about a particular artist, they create their own project using that artist's style. For example, after a lesson about George Seurat, your child creates a painting using pointillism (dots). Our experienced teachers provide young students with enrichment in drawing, painting, sculpting, music and architecture. Included in the program are field trips to local sights, culminating in a visit to the Art Institute of Chicago. Each day the children have time for play in the gym or outside, weather permitting.

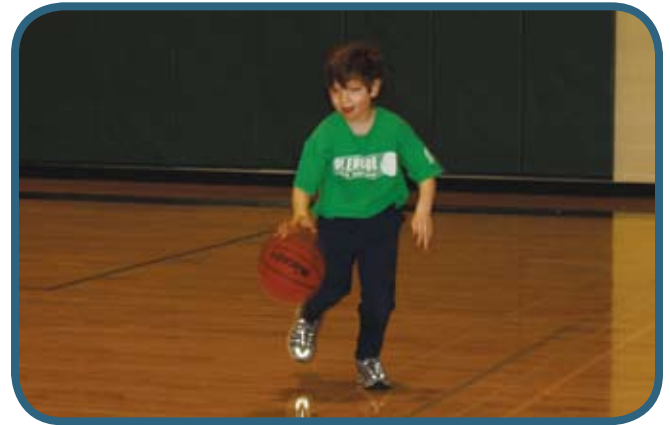
